

LIVE EDGE AXE THROWING

HOUSE POLICIES

Safety is the most important factor for all guests and staff at Live Edge

Please be aware that any violation of our safety policies or other unsafe behavior by any member of your group may result in you being unable to participate in your event, and/or removal from the premises. Your event fee will not be refunded.

CLOTHING

CLOSED-TOE SHOES ARE REQUIRED for anyone entering the throwing area.

Please wear comfortable clothing which allows you good range of motion. Loose clothing can also create unsafe conditions by limiting mobility and/or snagging on objects during your event. Your Axe Coach will exercise his/her discretion when meeting your group to determine if any items could present a safety risk and you may be asked to remove these items.

WHILE THROWING

You will be instructed in safety guidelines, throwing technique, and the structure of play upon arrival.

NEVER enter the throwing area until given permission to do so by your Axe Coach.

NEVER cross the throwing line until axes have come to rest either in the target or on the floor.

NEVER throw while a player is retrieving an axe in an adjacent lane. Throwers must wait behind the throwing line for all players in their lane to complete their throw before collecting their axe.

ALWAYS throw together and retrieve axes together!

NEVER leave the throwing lane with an axe.

Food and beverages are not permitted inside the throwing area safety line.

AXE COACHES

Follow all directions given by your Coach and other staff. Should you forget a safety rule, you will receive friendly but firm reminders from them. However, repeated failure to follow safety rules may result in your removal from the throwing area and/or facility. Please take their direction seriously, as all rules are in place for your safety.

ROUGHHOUSING & HORSEPLAY

We ask that all participants behave in a responsible manner. We are here to have fun, but safety must come first. Our staff will issue warnings for any roughhousing or horseplay. Repeated warnings may result in removal from the throwing area and/or the premises.

No trick shots or stunt throws will be permitted.

ALCOHOL

We ask that you arrive for your event alert and free from the influence of any substances, including alcohol. During your time with us, please drink responsibly. We believe that enjoying alcoholic beverages during your event is both possible and safe when done responsibly and in moderation. A limit of three alcoholic beverages per guest will be enforced while you are throwing.

Please be aware that arrival under the influence or excessive consumption during your event WILL result in removal from the throwing area and/or the facility by our staff. Should this occur, please realize that they are doing so not only for your safety, but for that of your group, other groups, and our staff. Refunds will not be issued for guests who are removed for safety violations.

<u>AXES</u>

House axes will be provided for guests to throw. Outside axes may be permitted after our staff have inspected them for safety.

UNDERAGE PARTICIPANTS

The age limit for participating in axe throwing is 8 years old. All participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign a waiver on their behalf before participating. All underage throwers must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

All premises at Live Edge Axe Throwing are under 24 hour video recording surveillance.
